"This will present appeal and claim in behalf of Seattle, WA Conductor E. W. Hall for complete record clearance and for pay for all time lost, including investigation account formal reprimand and one (1) year probation for alleged violation of GCOR Rules 1.3.3 Circulars, Instructions, and Notices, specifically General Notice 338, BNSF Guidelines for TY&E Employee Attendance (failure to perform service as a full time employee during February, March and April, 2005.)


FINDINGS

The Board finds that the parties herein are Carrier and Employee as defined by the Railway Labor Act, as amended; that the Board has jurisdiction over this dispute; and that due notice of the hearing thereon has been given to the parties.

Upon careful review of the record, the Board respectfully sustains the claim.
