STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim in behalf of Trinidad, CO Conductor J.T. Cox for pay for all time lost, including time attending investigation and complete record clearance account Level S, 30-day record suspension for alleged violation of Rule S-13.5 of the BNSF TY&E Safety Supplement No. 1, effective April 1, 1998, including revisions (alleged getting on moving equipment) on March 26, 2002.


FINDINGS:

Public Law Board No. 7221, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that the parties herein are Carrier and Employees within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as amended; that the Board has jurisdiction over the dispute herein; and that the parties to the dispute were given due notice of the hearing and did participate therein.


We have carefully reviewed the record in its entirety. First, we find no evidence of any procedural irregularity or unfairness in the conduct of the hearing. On the merits, the record demonstrates that the Carrier has met its burden of proving Claimant's guilt by substantial evidence. We see no reason to disturb the penalty determined appropriate by the Carrier.
